The Highland County Board of Commissioners will receive sealed bids until **9:15 AM., Local Time, January 27, 2021.**

Bidders shall submit sealed bids for Reinforced Concrete Storm Sewer Pipe to the Highland County Board of Commissioners, 119 Governor Foraker Place, Suite 211 Hillsboro, OH 45133.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in conformance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid guaranty may be in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit pursuant to chapter 1305 of the Revised Code in the amount of 5% of Bid, or in the form of a 10% Bid Bond conforming to Section 153.54 and 153.57, Ohio Revised Code.

The Highland County Board of Commissioners reserves the right to waive any informalities and to reject any or all bids.

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

Bids will be received by the Highland County Board of Commissioners (herein called the "Owner"), at the office of The Highland County Board of Commissioners until **9:15 A.M., January 27, 2021, local time**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope, addressed to the Highland County Board of Commissioners, 119 Governor Foraker Place, Suite 211 Hillsboro, Ohio 45133. Each sealed envelope containing a bid must be plainly marked on the outside as bid for:

Reinforced Concrete Storm Sewer Pipe

and the envelope should bear on the outside the name of the bidder, their address, their license number, if applicable. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed to the owner at the above address.

All bids must be made on the bid form. All blank spaces for bid prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, and bid form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Only one copy of the bid form is required.

The owner may waive any minor defects or informalities or reject any or all bids. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for opening of bids. Any bid received after the time for the opening specified shall not be considered. No bidder may withdraw a bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Should there be reasons why the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period, the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the owner and the bidder.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid guaranty in conformance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid guaranty may be in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit pursuant to chapter 1305 of the Revised Code in the amount of 5% of bid, or in the form of a 10% bid bond conforming to Section 153.54 and 153.57, Ohio Revised Code.

A performance bond and a payment bond, each in the amount of 100% of the contract price, with a corporate surety approved by the owner, will be required for the faithful performance of the contract.

Attorneys-in-fact who sign bid bonds or payment bonds and performance bonds must file with each bond a certified and effective dated copy of their power of attorney.

The party to whom the contract is awarded will be required to execute the agreement and obtain the performance bond and payment bond within ten calendar days from the date when Notice of Award is delivered to the bidder. The Notice of Award shall be accompanied by the necessary agreement. In case of failure of the bidder to execute the agreement, the owner may at his option consider the bidder in default, in which case the bid bond accompanying the proposal shall become the property of the owner.

pay the Obligee the difference not to exceed ten (10%) percent of the penalty hereof between the amount specified in the bid, or the costs, in connection with the resubmission, of printing new contract documents, required advertising and printing and mailing notices to prospective bidders, whichever is less, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect. If the Obligee accepts the bid of the Principal and the Principal within ten days after the awarding of the contract, enters into a proper contract in accordance with the bid, plans, details, specifications, and bills of material, which said contract is made a part of this bond the same as through set forth herein; and

IF THE SAID Principal shall well and faithfully perform each and every condition of such contract; and indemnify the Obligee against all damage suffered by failure to perform such contract according to the provisions thereof and in accordance with the plans, details, specification, and bills of material therefore; and shall pay all lawful claims of subcontractors, materialmen, and laborers, for labor performed and materials furnished in the carrying forward, performing, or completing of said contract; we agreeing and assenting that this undertaking shall be for the benefit of any materialman or laborer having a just claim, as well as for the Obligee herein; then this obligation shall be void; otherwise the same shall remain in full force and effect; it being expressly understood and agreed that the liability of the Surety for any and all claims hereunder shall in no even exceed the penal amount of this obligation as herein stated.
